

## IWHA HIGH POINT AWARD PROGRAM

Welcome to the IWHA High Point Award Program for 2009. This program is open to all paid members of IWHA and their horses. The following are the program rules.

To nominate your horse you must:

- A. Be a current IWHA member. Membership dues for both owner and rider must be paid prior to nomination. (No dues payment for Life members)
- B. Fill out a nomination form for each horse legibly and completely. Nominations must be completed prior to showing the horse for points.
- C. Choose your Division, either Performance or Pleasure.
- D. Declare your nomination for either INSTATE or OUT-OF-STATE shows, a separate form is required for each.
- E. For OUT-OF-STATE nominations choose your division: Performance or Pleasure. We are no longer separating divisions into categories below. All Pleasure divisions will be combined into a single category.
- F. Choose your category within the INSTATE Division:  
**PERFORMANCE:** Open, Amateur, Ladies, Specialty, or Juvenile (17 & under)  
**PLEASURE:** Model 2 & under, Model 3 & over, Plan./Park Pleas. 2gt. Eng., Plan./Park Pleas. 3gt. Eng., Plan./Park Pleas. 2gt. West., Plan./Park Pleas. 3gt. West., Park Perf. 2gt., Park Perf. 3gt., Lite Shod 2gt. Eng., Lite Shod 3gt. Eng., Lite Shod 2gt. West., Lite Shod 3gt. West., Trail Pleasure, SSH, or Juvenile (17 & under. NOTE: Juveniles must be 17 or under as of Jan. 1, 2008.) There must be a minimum of three(3)horses/category to receive year end awards (except Juvenile).
- G. Nomination fee is \$10 per Category per Division (for both Instate & Out-of-State).
- H. Points accumulate by placing ahead of other horses in the show ring--1 point is available for each horse in the class. Example; 5 horses in the class...you place 1st...you receive 5 points. 5 horses in the class...you place 5th...you receive 1 point. To be in the class, a horse must make the gate and be shown under the judge. A horse excused by the judge is in the class. A scratched, a withdrawn, or a no-show at the gate is not in the class.
- I. Double points are awarded for shows of two or more days in length with 5 or more TWH designated classes in total. Classes added the day of the show do not count. Shows that are 2 days in length, but all TWH or SSH classes are 1 day will be counted as a single point show.
- J. Points reports are not required for IWHA or SSHAI shows, these will be collected from class sheets. A point report for all non-IWHA or non-SSHA I must be sent within 30 days of the show. It must be accompanied by a signed show bill. The show bill class list must designate TWH, Plant./Park Pleas., Park Performance, Lite Shod, Trail Pleasure, or SSH for points to count.
- K. Change of ownership: Points stay with the nominated horse as long as there is no change of Division (Performance vs. Pleasure). A change of Category requires nomination by the new owner. Change of ownership should be reported to the point's chairperson ASAP.
- L. Deadlines: All nominations must be made by Aug. 15th. Send point reports to the point's chairperson within 30 days of each show. Use a separate point report for each show. Send signed show bill with each report (can be signed by any show official or any elected official of sponsoring organization). All points must be in by Oct. 25th to count. NOTE: If you have a late Oct. show--contact the point's chairperson before Oct. 26th to see if arrangements can be made to phone in your results.
