Horses competing for TWHBEA Versatility Points  
are not allowed to wear bands no matter what  
shoe size/division they are collecting points.

1. Out of state horses must have current health certificate and IDOA permit number - to obtain call (217) 782-4944.
2. TWHBEA & SSHBEA registration numbers must be presented at show.
3. Current (one year) negative Coggins required. Must present original and leave copy for office.
4. The Affiliating HIO's rules will be followed for regular classes.
5. TWHBEA Versatility rules will be followed for all versatility classes.
6. SSHBEA rules will be followed for all Spotted Horse classes/ SSH classes are sanctioned by SSHBEA
7. Youth Classes are for any youth 17 and under and all Youth Riders are required to wear a helmet
8. All Thrown Shoes will be Inspected and Weighed before a Class will be tied
9. No Tungsten allowed in Country Pleasure, Trail Pleasure, Lite Shod, Classic Park Pleasure and Park Performance as per HIO Shoeing Regulations.
10. Showbill Subject to Change/ Please check the showbill at the office for official classes
11. Action devices allowed for Performance classes only/ No plastic wrap allowed on showgrounds
12. Any person on USDA suspension may only participate at this show as a spectator
